### **Cornwall Councillor Report.**

Cllr Rushworth repeated that it had been a very strange year and he had relied on getting information from the people of St Ervan but he did not have a lot to talk about, he had managed to get the street lighting agreed and that should be in place this year. CC are very supportive of Newquay airport as it is essential for our businesses when we get up and running again. the Budget had been set and again the administration had raised it by another 4.99% which he did not support, he said that he is standing again as the Councillor for the area but this could be his last meeting and he said it had been an honour and privilege.

### **Police report.**

Ins Butler-Card reported that he had only been in place since last April and he is doing the best he can but he has concerns he said it is important to work with the community to reduce crime and the figures this year show that but there is still problems with drugs and Anti Social Behaviour. The Police had a 10 day purge and arrested people in possession of £10,000 of cocaine and cannabis which was taken off the streets and he said they were expecting it to be very busy after lockdown as the people who normally went abroad would be coming here.
